

# PowerShell on macOS

Wait. What? PowerShell on macOS? Here's how.

## Brew .NET and PowerShell

Don't have homebrew? Get it at [brew.sh](https://brew.sh)

```
brew cask install dotnet
```

Update OpenSSL

```
brew install openssl
```

```
ln -s /usr/local/opt/openssl/lib/libcrypto.1.0.0.dylib /usr/local/lib/
```

```
ln -s /usr/local/opt/openssl/lib/libssl.1.0.0.dylib /usr/local/lib/
```

```
brew cask install powershell
```

## Install Azure PowerShell modules

To download and install the Azure PowerShell module package use the following PowerShell code:

```
Install-Package -Name Az
```

Test if the installation was successful with the cmdlet

```
Import-Module Az | Login-AzAccount
```

You should be prompted to go to <https://microsoft.com/devicelogin> to enter the provided code and your Azure admin credentials.
